The teachers of English of Dr. Nassau College Quintus have decided to encourage and help those students who are interested in getting their Cambridge Advanced Certificate.

### WHY ?

- To develop advanced English language skills and prepare for the internationally-recognised Certificate of Advanced English (CAE)

### HOW?

- Three Groups: Exam Group (years 4-6), General Group (years 2-4) and Introduction Group (year 1/2)
- Only English spoken in class
- Materials provided by the British Council



### WHEN?

- The Exam Group and General Group start in September of each year. The Introduction Group starts in February
- 1 lesson per week + homework (no homework for Introduction Group)

### RESULTS?

- We do not guarantee success, but up to now, all our students who have taken their CAE exam have passed!

### COSTS?

- No extra costs for the lessons at school
- Exam costs: around 265 euros payable to the British Council

Exams take place on 2 separate days (written part & speaking exam) in Groningen, Zwolle, or Leeuwarden.
